INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The Trauma Nursing Core Course™ (TNCC®) is a one day course developed by the Emergency Nurses Association® to present a firm foundation in trauma nursing and to provide nurses with core or basic trauma cognitive knowledge and psychomotor skills that are associated with the delivery of professional nursing care to the trauma patient.

The goal of the TNCC instructor course is to prepare nurses to effectively teach the TNCC provider course.

The instructor course is open to current TNCC Providers who were recognized as having instructor potential during their provider course. After the instructor course, instructor candidates must be monitored teaching within 12 months to become a TNCC instructor.
